Crawlee offers fast and scalable crawling capabilities with an MIT license, making it a solid choice when you need to crawl many pages quickly—especially useful for competitor research or bulk listing updates.

6. Automatisch: Build Custom Workflows Without Code

Automatisch automates repetitive tasks using visual workflows. AGPLv3 licensed (but commercial use is allowed if you don't modify the core), it's perfect

for chaining scraping, AI processing, and Etsy uploads into a single automated pipeline.

7. MCP: Integrating APIs with Ease

MCP servers are open-source tools that simplify API integrations—ideal for connecting scraped data to Etsy’s API or other marketplace tools. The permissive licensing supports commercial usage and integration in Etsy workflows.
